Creative Ways to Read as a Family

Nourishing the Meal Time Have your kids read recipes aloud to you while you're cooking dinner. From ingredient lists to cooking directions, this kind of family reading will help build vocabulary, fluency...and dessert!

Who Am I? Choose one of your child's favorite book characters, then describe his or her personality traits, problems, and physical descriptions until they guess the character's identity.

Reach Out and Read Boost family reading by involving loved-ones who live far away. Using Zoom or facetime, have your child share a book with relatives.

Academic Corner

When reading aloud, stop and ask open-ended questions to check for understanding and model how to think and ask questions.

SEL/Wellness at home

Think out loud. When your child hears your thinking process, it helps them understand how to cope with frustration and solve problems: For example, "Whoops. My favorite shopping bag has a hole in it. I'd better take another one with me to the grocery store."
